FORMAT: Single FITA I – 600 Round Indoor Tournament (STAR FITA)

Recurve will shoot in the Mid-day round and Awards will follow, Compound will shoot in the PM Session with Awards to follow. Depending on registration there may be an AM Session for Novice- Genesis Class and Overflow from the main classes of compound and Recurve. To guarantee a lane to compete, archers are encouraged to register as soon as possible. Registrations will be tracked by date and time of submission online.

Bowman and Cub Classes,

Recurve Bow and FITA Bare bow - 60 arrows from 18 meters; - 60 cm target face single 10 ring target, outer 10 ring scoring.

Compound Bow- 60 arrows from 18 meters; - 40 cm target face (choice of single spot, triangle or vertical three-spot face; outer 10 ring scoring.)

Novice Class –Any archer new to the sport, equipment limitations or skill level limitations, who can only consistently hit a target at 9 meters. (Archers will be registered to regular age class unless a club director sends a pre-approval email to hearnarchery@gmail.com)-60 arrows from 9 meters; - 60 cm target face single 10 ring target, outer 10 ring scoring.

Juniors and Cadets Classes,

Recurve Bow and FITA Bare bow - 60 arrows from 18 meters; - 40 cm target face (choice of single-spot, triangle or vertical three-spot face); outer 10 ring scoring.

Compound Bow- 60 arrows from 18 meters; - 40 cm target face (choice of single spot, triangle or vertical three-spot face; use inner 10 ring scoring.)

Genesis Class, Genesis Bare Bows with NO sights - 60 arrows from 18 meters; - 60 cm target face single 10 ring target, outer 10 ring scoring. (Note: if sights are added to the bow it is then grouped with Compound at the appropriate age group)

CLASSIFICATIONS:

- Junior (20 & under, born in or after 1993)
- Cadet (17 & under, born in or after 1996)
- Cub (14 & under, born in or after 1999)
- Bowman (12 & under, born in or after 2001)
- Open Bare bow Novice (High school students and younger grouped by Female/Male)

No registration will be accepted the day of the event. All registration must be received by January 23rd, 8pm. Registration is to be submitted online only.

Special NOTICE:

1. Lane size will be 80cm and facility will be remarked to give appropriate lane size
2. AM round participants will include overflow compound, recurve, novice and genesis class archers
3. Mid-day will be for Recurve archers and awards will be immediately after scoring is completed.*
4. PM round will be Compound archers and awards will be immediately after scoring is completed.*
 - a. **Space is limited: Priority will be given to Arizona USAA JOAD members; First 32 Recurve archers will compete during the mid-day time and first 32 Compound archers will compete in the evening time. After the 32 archers per class have registered, additional registration is accepted and will be given a morning participation time.
5. The tournament range will be run with AB/CD lines with a maximum of 32 archers per session
6. Waivers: Two part waiver will be required at registration, All archers and their Parent or Guardian will be required to sign an acknowledgment sheet, stating that they have read, & understand liabilities and responsibilities. These waivers will be available at checkin as well as posted at the event.

SPECIAL NOTICE: Registration is accepted on a first come – first serve basis. Lane assignments will be given on priority of registration date and time. If there are more than 32 Recurve or 32 Compound archers that wish to participate the archers will be placed in the AM shooting time.
