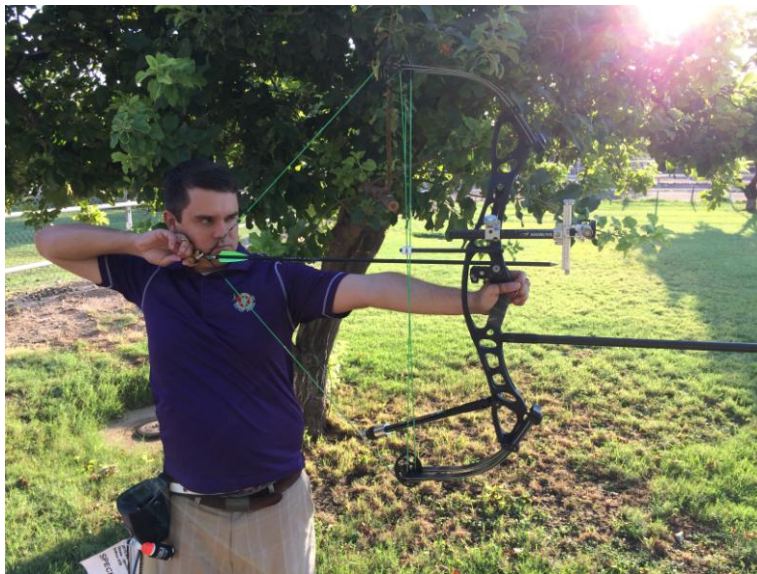


Michael Speck
